

You may leave your offering in the plates. Your generosity allows the work of this place nurture beloved community, grow authentic Christian faith, and live Christ-inspired action.



Communion loaf — whole wheat flour, molasses, yeast, salt. Juice — grape juice, vitamin C. Gluten free — sorghum, tapioca, millet & rice flours; sea salt, honey, canola oil, water, ginger ale, egg.
